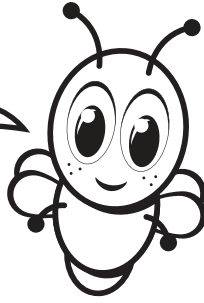


# Blinky's Family Challenge

2. **What kind of plans does God make?** *Good ones*



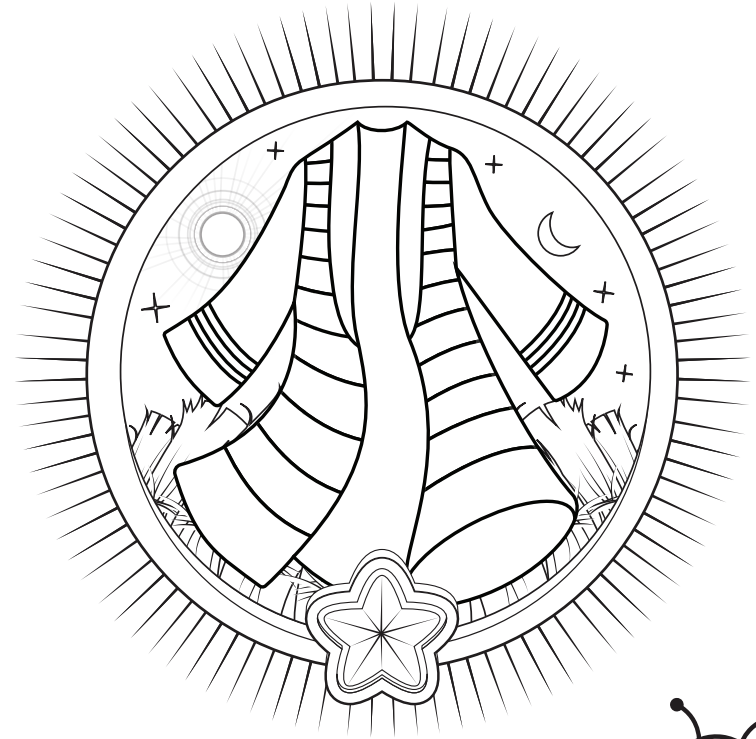
